The Resistible Rise of Arturo Ui

Performed in Japanese

In January 2020, KAAT will launch into the new year with a major production by its Artistic Director, Akira Shirai, of Bertolt Brecht's powerful satirical allegory about the 1930s ascent to power of Adolf Hitler and his Nazi party, "The Resistible Rise of Arturo Ui."

In this famed work, the German playwright mirrors events in Hitler's quest for power as he chronicles the efforts of Arturo Ui, a 1930s Chicago gangster, to control the cauliflower trade by eliminating all the competition.

For this production, as well as casting Tsuyoshi Kusanagi in the title role, Shirai also enlists the world-famous Osaka Monaurail funk band to play their own and James Brown music live on stage in his innovative and provocative take on Brecht's controversial 1941 drama.

And though Kusanagi first worked with Shirai in KAAT's 2018 production of "Ballyturk," a manic physical comedy by Irish playwright Enda Walsh, it will be exciting to see how he now extends his talents even further to portray the flashy mobster Arturo Ui.
